

































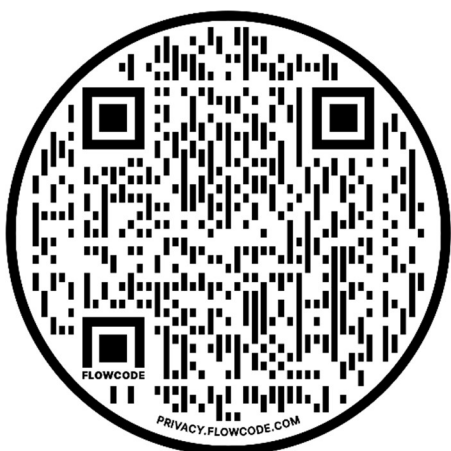

<b>Large print keyboard (Mac/PC)</b> 	Helps to see and use the larger keys for use of a computer	Vision
<b>Large shoe horn</b> 	An aid to assist in putting on and removing shoes	Physical

<b>LED Floor light and magnifier</b> 	Aid for visual impairment.	Vision
<b>Lighted Safety Cane 1</b> 	To aid in balance and mobility with a built in light for increased visibility in low lit areas	Vision/Physical
<b>Livescribe 3 Smartpen</b> 	A note taking aid with dictation and instant transfer to paired computer, tablet or mobile device	Learning
<b>Livescribe Notebook</b>	Helps with the Smart Pen to record	Learning
<b>Mag RX LED Lighted medicine bottle magnifier</b> 	A visual aid to help with small print on prescription bottles.	Vision
<b>Magnetic Jumbo Timer w/red indicator</b> 	An alternative visual representation of time. Aids in learning how to read time and interpret the passage of time. Also can aid in timer needs for low vision	Vision/Learning
<b>Reading Magnifier w/desk-top base</b> 	Visual aid for desktop reading or working with small objects	Vision
<b>Talking Instant Read Clinical Thermometer</b> 	An auditory aid that speaks the thermometer reading as well as having a digital read out	Vision
<b>Talking pharmacist prescription recorder</b> 	Recites prescription instructions given by the pharmacist to the user.	Vision
<b>Turning Knob Operator</b> 	A fine motor aid with the ability to turn on switches, turn knobs, handles among other things.	Physical

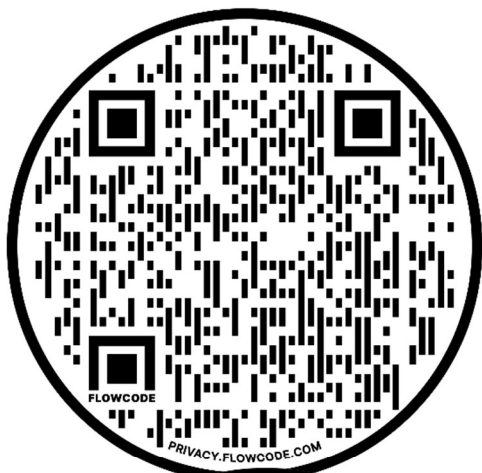
<b>Kensington trackball mouse</b> 	Alternative computing aid for fine motor skills	Physical
<b>OptiVisor</b> 	Visual aid for working with small objects	Vision
<b>Beep Ball (1 Yellow &amp; 1 Red)</b> 	Soft foam ball aids in audio signaling and sensory input	Sensory/Vision
<b>Jar Opener pad</b> 	Rubberized pad that grips lids and jar tops to aid in removal	Physical
<b>Folding Cane (2)</b> 	Compact, folding cane for visual impairment	Vision
<b>Magnifying Sheet</b> 	Portable magnifier. Can be used for reading magazines or newspapers.	Vision
<b>Braille Measuring Tape</b> 	Measuring tape with braille 6-inch tactually marked extension.	Vision
<b>Talking Watch (2)</b> 	Audibly reads the time when you press the talk button.	Vision
<b>Adaptive Pen</b> 	Designed to help improve the handwriting. Triangular base balances and guides the hand. Wide triangular base increases stability.	Physical
<b>Easy Scissors</b> 	Easy squeeze scissors help children, toddlers, elderly adults, or those with low coordination or hand strength cut safely and easily.	Physical
<b>Adaptive Plate &amp; Utensils (2 sets)</b> 	eating aid cutlery is designed to help people with hand tremors or Parkinson's Disease hold utensils securely.	Physical
<b>Braille Playing Cards</b> 	Playing cards with Braille. They come with .50 inch high numbers.	Vision
